The Keystone State Gay Rodeo Association (KSGRA) is a 501c3 non-profit organization whose purpose is to promote a country and western lifestyle and rodeo type events within the LGBT community and their allies.

KSGRA was founded in 2005 by a group of individuals with the passion of bringing gay rodeo back to the east coast as well as being a welcoming environment for those that enjoy country and horse related social events including trail riding, rodeo, horse shows, fundraising for charity, country music and dancing. Since 2005 KSGRA has produced many events including trail rides, fundraisers, dances and an annual charity rodeo. KSGRA is a member association of the International Gay Rodeo Association (IGRA).



The International Gay Rodeo Association, has officially been roping and riding since 1985 and currently has over 1,600 members in 19 local associations around North America. We are the largest organization in the world coordinating rodeo events specifically welcoming lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender as well as heterosexual participants and spectators. In 2018 IGRA member associations will produce rodeos across North America and entertain thousands of rodeo fans.

IGRA is composed of many regional gay rodeo associations, and sanctions a season of rodeo events which culminates in an annual World Gay Rodeo Finals®. IGRA events are intended to allow all contestants, regardless of sexual and gender identity, to compete in rodeo sports without discrimination. The organization helps spread appreciation for Western culture and the sport of rodeo, while serving as a fundraising vehicle benefiting many charitable organizations. Since its inception, IGRA rodeos have raised over 4 million dollars to various charities.

Festival Setup/Breakdown

Setup begins at 1:00 PM on Friday, June 22 and ends at 8:00 PM and begins again on each day of the rodeo at 7:00 AM. All vendors MUST by setup by 9:00 AM each day of the rodeo. Tear down does not start until 5:00 PM or the completion of the rodeo. **All vendors must remain setup until the completion of the rodeo.** Vendors are responsible for the setup, clean up and breakdown of their own area in a timely and orderly manner. Vendors must cooperate with each other and respect the integrity of the facility while transporting and removing their wares and equipment. All vendors are responsible to clean up any trash or refuse in the immediate vicinity or their vendor location or associated with their vendor activities. Any vendor not in compliance will be subject to the additional clean up fee of \$50.

<p>The agreement to rent a booth space is made upon the express condition that the hosting facility, Keystone State Gay Rodeo Association, and their board of directors and volunteers, hereinafter referred to as the Lessor, shall be free from all liabilities and claims for damages and/or suits for or by reason of any injury or injuries to any person or persons or property of any kind whatsoever, whether the person or property of Lessee, its agents or employees, or third persons, from any cause or causes whatsoever while in or upon said premises or any part thereof during the term of this agreement or occasioned by any occupancy or use of said premises or any activity carried on by lessee in connection therewith. The Lessee hereby covenants and agrees to indemnify and save harmless the Lessor from all liabilities, charges, expenses (including counsel fees) and costs on account of or by reason of any such injuries, liabilities, claims, suits, or losses however occurring or damages growing out of same. The Lessee warrants and guarantees that Lessee is properly insured for all time periods and places covered by this agreement.
